













European Countries Game

What you need:

- 1 Dice
- 1 Pawn per player
- 1 Game board
- Questions' cards

Game Rules

Set your game figure to the "Departure" field.
Roll and move according to the score.
Take a question card and answer the question.
You get 1 point for the correct answer.
The player with the most points wins.
The game is finished when a player reaches the "Arrival" field.

Some ideas for this game:

- Write questions on the board to be answered
- Have a corresponding worksheet completed
- As a communication exercise

Samples for questions:

- 1. What do you know about this country?
- 2. Name the neighbouring countries?
- 3. What ist the national food/specialty of this country?
- 4. Which language is spoken in this country?
- 5. Do you know the cultural characteristics of this country?
- 6. Which are the colours of this country's flag?

Teachers'sheet - Proposals

This game could be used for school subjects like geography or history in order to introduce a topic or to edit repetitions in a playful way.

- The teacher could write further questions on the board about the countries mentioned – Students should complete the list of the countries of the European Union.
- Enter the main cities (possibly with their landmarks) on a map of Europe.
- On a sheet, add the nationality in each country (spelling exercise).
- Offer the students a map with the main rivers of Europe. They should enter the names of the rivers.
- Have a map of the European Union divided into climatic zones.
- The students should draw the position of the mountains in Europe and enter their names (Alps, Pyrenees, etc.).
